Regular Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. with all board members and Supt. Hafer present.

Verification of Publication

Motion Cox, 2nd Martindale, to verify publication of minutes/notice in the Custer County Chief. Motion passed 6-0.

Consent Agenda

Motion Bass, 2nd Milleson to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed 6-0.

Administrative Report

- a. Mr. Hafer reported the K-6 teachers worked with ESU10 in order to choose the new reading series to be adopted and purchased this spring for 2017-18 implementation.
- b. The board was updated regarding various facilities items including minor repairs and ongoing maintenance.
- c. An update on the Sandhills Beef in Schools program was given. Great work by the kitchen staff makes this program successful. Further, those interested in donating beef or processing dollars should contact Supt. Hafer.
- d. Mr. Hafer reminded the board of school closing and communication procedures. Parents and patrons are encouraged to contact the main office with questions.
