Regular Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. All board members were present except Teahon who was excused. Also present: Dale Hafer.

Verification of Publication:

Motion Milleson, second Bass to verify publication of minutes/notice in the Custer County Chief. Motion passed 5-0.

Consent Agenda:

Motion Cox, second Martindale to approve consent agenda. Motion passed 5-0.

Administrative Report:

Administrative Report:

1. Buildings and grounds needs were discussed by Mr. Hafer including pricing updates for tuck pointing, stage curtains, and other projects to be considered as possible budget items for 2016-17.
2. Mr. Hafer informed the board Pam Scheer had been hired for the 3rd grade position and Shelby Hamilton for the 5/6 grade para position.
3. The board was informed of revised student-parent handbooks will be brought to the July board meeting for approval for 2016-17.
4. Mr. Hafer discussed the start of the 2016-17 budget process and asked the board to be considering overall goals and directions to be further discussed in July.

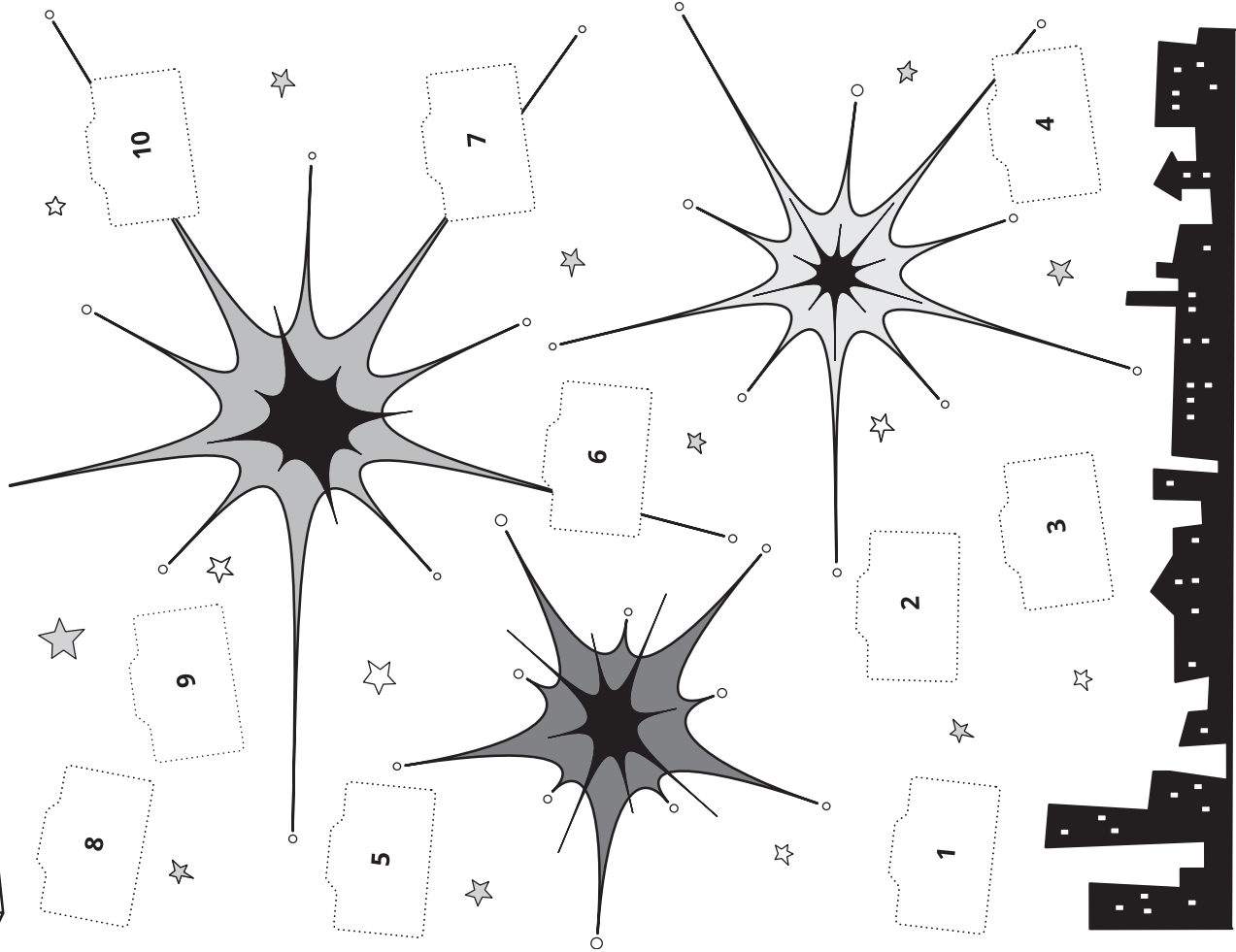

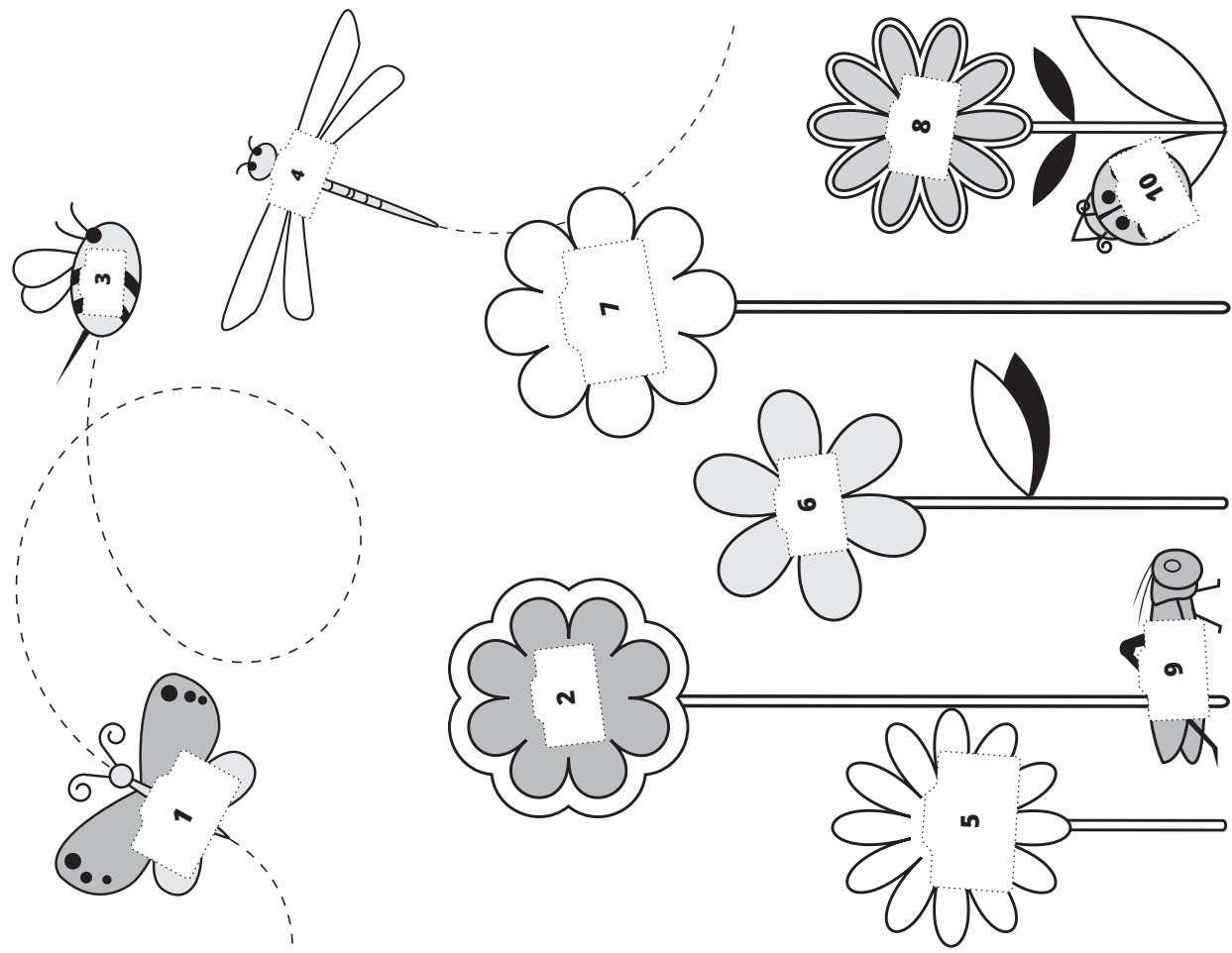
