- d. Mrs. Collier discussed the needed transfer to the activity fund to shore up balances of specific activity accounts within the fund that is in tonight's action items.
- e. Mr. Furrow informed the board that Ms. Jaylee Simonson would need to be added as a signatory on the school's bank accounts. This will be an action item in the February meeting.
- f. Policy Review Mr. Furrow shared and discussed the policies that were re-written by Jim Luebbe from NASB to include more safety drill requirements and clean up redundancies. These revisions are on tonight's action items.
- g. Mr. Furrow discussed the Certified Staff Negotiated Agreement that is in tonight's action items for approval.
- h. Other Mrs. Collier shared with the board a couple of styles for new board chairs and their costs. There was also a brief discussion on adding HUDL cameras to our current subscription package.
