5. Public comment and requests to address the board. There was requests to address the board this meeting.

6. Teacher Presentation on NETA Conference – Mrs. Jeanine Saner, Mrs. Cindy Simonson, Mrs. Trish Rodocker, and Mrs. Julie Teahon presented to the board. They shared the presentation they did for the conference, which was based on the ways they are using technology in the classroom. They also shared some new ideas that they picked up at the conference. The teachers also thanked the board for giving them the opportunity to attend.

## 7. Discussion Items/Administrative Report:

- a. Sandhills Thedford Co-op Report Mr. Furrow reminded the board of the athletic banquet on Tuesday. Mr. Teahon encouraged everyone to attend.
- b. NASB Legislative Review Mr. Furrow updated the board on legislation that will impact education that passed during the last session.
- c. ESSER Update Mr. Furrow and Mrs. Collier submitted a reimbursement request for the computers that were purchased earlier in the spring. This is the first draw on either ESSER II or ESSER III.
- d. Update on Halsey Gym AC and Boiler Mr. Furrow updated the board on the timeline for the gym AC project and informed the board of the boiler replacement estimate that was approved by ALICAP.
- e. Interest Payment for Financing Mr. Furrow informed the board that the first interest payment on the financing for the activity building would come due June 15<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Collier, Mrs. Milleson, and Mr. Larsen discussed the transaction of the funds.
- f. Fleet discussion Mr. Furrow shared an updated fleet worksheet with the board. He also shared the plan of purchasing a new suburban from Gateway. This is an action item for tonight. He also contacted Ranchland about purchasing a van.
- g. Policy Review Mr. Furrow informed the board that we needed to review the policies on Attendance and Discipline this month.
- h. Graduation Wrap Up Mr. Furrow and Mr. Teahon commented on how well the ceremony went. They both agreed that the kids speeches were excellent. The board also commended Mrs. Rodocker for her work in putting on the ceremony.
