## **Sandhills Public Schools Board of Education Regular Meeting August 8, 2016**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with all board members present including Ann Collier and Dale Hafer.

### **Verification of Publication**

Motion Teahon, second Bass, to verify publication of minutes/notice in the Custer County Chief. Motion passed 6-0.

### **Consent Agenda**

Motion Bass, second Milleson to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed 6-0.

### **Administrative Report**

- a. Ann Collier was present to give a report on the successful transition to Software Unlimited, the new software system for district accounting.
- b. Mr. Hafer discussed various opinions and considerations related to certified staff duties in combined classroom situations.
- c. Board Members Martindale and Cox reported on the buildings and grounds committee trip to Arthur County to view their new modular classroom building.
- d. Mr. Hafer reported the new scoreboard should be delivered/installed around the 19th of August.
- e. There will be a recognition plaque ordered soon to recognize participating donors in the Sandhills Beef in School Program.
- f. Mr. Hafer informed the board of various NASB professional development opportunities this fall.
- g. Mr. Hafer presented preliminary budget information. The board directed Mr. Hafer to prepare 3 options of the 2016-17 budget in preparation for the August 22nd budget retreat.

- e. Motion Cox, second Martindale to authorize Supt. Hafer to surplus excess kitchen supplies and equipment. Motion passed 6-0.
- f. Motion Milleson, second Bass to approve the 2nd reading and revision of NASB recommended board policies as presented. Motion passed 6-0.
- g. Motion by Milleson, second Martindale to acknowledge the 1st reading of NASB revised board policies as presented. Motion passed 6-0.
- h. Board President Anderson adjourned the meeting at 9:50 p.m.
