

## USEFUL INFORMATION

### Note to MAC Users:

You can use a MAC to input information but there have been issues noted in printing from the MAC. The only solution that is known is to print via a PC.

### MUST COMPLETE THIS PAGE - Basic Data Input Area

The Basic Data Input Area is designed to help common information flow throughout the Budget Form.

### Cover Page - Page 1

The Total Property Tax Requirement is carried forward from Page 2; however, you will need to input how much of that tax request is for Principal and Interest on Bonds.

Outstanding Bonded Indebtedness - if you complete the worksheet pages this will fill in automatically. If you do not you will need to indicate your balances as of September 1.

### Pages 2 through 4 (If you utilize the Worksheet Pages - Begin Inputting on Worksheet Pages)

These pages are currently completed with formulas which pull from the Worksheet Pages. **If you utilize the Worksheet Pages, Pages 2 through 4 will be completed automatically for you.** If you do not wish to utilize the worksheet pages you can simply type in your numbers on Pages 2 through 4. The only cells with formulas that cannot be over-written are those that provide an essential calculation (example - Total Resources Available).

A complete and accurate budget should have the prior year Balance Forward **equal** Total of Beginning Balances. We have built into the spreadsheet a comparison between these two numbers. If these two numbers **do not agree** a statement will appear indicating it must equal prior year balance forward.

We have also built in a comparison between the Total Requirement and Total Resources Available. If these two numbers **do not agree** in the budget you will receive the message "Budget Not Balanced".

### Worksheet Pages - **FOR YOUR USE ONLY - NOT TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE**

The last sheets of this file are worksheet (individual fund) pages. These pages are provided for your use; however, you do not have to use them. For more information about the worksheets, see the Budget Guidelines. **If you do utilize the Worksheet Pages, Pages 2 through 4 will be completed automatically for you.**

### Moving From Page to Page:

There are several ways to move around your budget form. You can hold down the CTRL and hit either Page Down (Moves you ahead a sheet) or Page Up (Moves you to previous sheet). The other option is to use your mouse to click on the different sheet tabs.

### I Want to See Descriptions on Left When Inputting Numbers in Budget Column:

On the "View" ribbon in the Window area there is an item called Freeze Panes. Freeze Panes allows you to tell the computer what columns and/or rows you wish to see at all times. Freeze Panes will freeze whatever rows are above your active cell and also whatever columns are to the left of your active cell. By choosing the option again it will turn the option off.

### The Cell Is Locked:

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL PASSWORDS BE GIVEN OUT. Either the cell is locked because it contains a formula or you are trying to input information in the wrong cell.

### You Note Any Errors Or Have Any Problems:

We have tested this spreadsheet through various methods to help identify any problem areas and to ensure formulas are correct. However, we cannot account for all the variables that occur with each individual budget. If you feel there is an error in a formula please contact us immediately so we can go over the problem(s) and if necessary correct the situation.

- Election Ballot and Certification of Election Results for a successful election to exceed the Property Tax Authority (if applicable)
- Election Ballot and Certification of Election Results for a successful election to override the levy limitation (if applicable)
- Election Ballot and Certification of Election Results for a successful election to exceed the expenditure limitation (if applicable)
- Joint Public Agency & Interlocal Agreements is indicated by checking the box. If school district answers YES, the Report of Joint Public Agency & Interlocal Agreements is due on or before September 30th and should be included with budget submission or filed separately with the APA. **Property Tax Request MUST also be within the School District's Property Tax Request Authority.**

If the total levy on Line 16 is \$1.05, or less, the levy limitation per State Statute Section 77-3442 has been met.

If Total of Line 16 is greater than \$1.05 and you **did not** hold a successful election to override the levy, you are in violation of the levy lid. The school district **must reduce property taxes** to meet the levy limitation.

If Total of Line 16 is greater than \$1.05 and you **held** a successful election to override the levy, which is in effect for the you must **attach a copy of the election ballot and the certified election returns** to your budget.

**Qualified Capital Purpose Undertaking Fund levy.** A district may only exceed the maximum levy of five and one-fifth cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in any year if (i) the taxable valuation of the district is lower than the taxable valuation in the year in which the district last issued capital purpose undertaking bonds or (ii) such maximum levy is insufficient to meet the annual principal and interest obligations for all capital purpose undertaking bonds. Projects beginning after April 19, 2016 can only have a maximum levy of three cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in any year. (Statute 79-10,110 & 79-10,110.02).

**Special Building Fund levy.** Limit on Building Fund levy of 14 cents (Statute 79-10,120)

**REMINDER:** School districts that have combined levies greater than \$1.20 or the combined levies that exceeded the maximum levy approved at a special election may be subject to petitions for the free holding of territory. Combined levies do not include levies for bonded indebtedness approved by the voters of a school district or levies for the refinancing of such bonded indebtedness.

**Voluntary Termination Exclusions**

Line 5 Amounts to pay for current and future sums agreed to be paid by a school district to certificated employees in exchange for a voluntary termination of employment occurring prior to 9/1/17

Line 6 Amount levied by school district at maximum levy to pay for current and future qualified voluntary termination incentives for certificated teachers pursuant to statute. The district officers of any school district in Nebraska shall have power, on the terms and conditions set forth in sections 10-702 to 10-716, to issue the bonds of the district for the purpose of (1) purchasing a site for and erecting thereon a schoolhouse or schoolhouses or a teacherage or teacherages, or for such purchase or erection, or purchasing an existing building or buildings for use as a schoolhouse or schoolhouses, including the site or sites upon which such building or buildings are located, and furnishing the same, in such district, (2) retiring registered warrants, and (3) paying for additions to or repairs for a schoolhouse or schoolhouses or a teacherage or teacherages.

School districts also have the ability to issue bonds as set forth in State Statute Section 79-10,110 for the purpose of paying amounts necessary for the abatement of environmental hazards, accessibility barrier elimination, or modifications for life safety code violations, indoor air quality, or mold abatement and prevention.
